

Interim transport support for Meeniyian residents

With the loss of their local supermarket last week to fire, Meeniyian residents without transport are advised they can access the current bus service to Leongatha to grocery shop on Thursdays. The service departs the V-Line stop at 10.16 am, and returns at 2.18pm. For further information on this service, contact Moon's Bus Lines on 5687 1249.

“Council will also provide an additional service on Mondays to Leongatha, initially for the next 4 weeks,” said Council’s Community Strengthening Coordinator Ned Dennis. “We will be able to fund this under the Transport Connections Program and will review the services after 4 weeks to measure the usage and to consider any variation to the times.”

This service will leave the V-Line stop at 9.30 am and return at approximately 12.30pm, commencing on Monday 23 March.

Alternatively the V/line coach service operates Monday to Friday, departing Meeniyian at 8.16am, and returning at 6.53pm.

“That’s a long wait for a return journey, but people may like to visit friends or catch a movie whilst they are in town,” said Ned.
